

## schème II

A research commission creating a physical platform for the development of a choreographic installation in the form of a performance arena equipped with a variety of technological tools specifically developed for the project and including an expressive data acquisition system, custom made wireless sensor boxes mounted on dancers and moving projections in the space of the performance. The performers navigate through virtual space and generate video images and soundscapes. schème II provides a time and space situation where the performer and the technological environment interact with each other forming an intelligent space.
